<u>Screening Process</u>: Screening of applications will take place after the application deadline, and only those applicants who have been successfully screened into the process will be invited for an interview. Notification of acceptance into the screening process will take place via email <u>or</u> telephone. Interviews will be conducted by an Assessment Board comprised of KMK and DFO staff members.

Employer: All successful candidates will be employed with Fisheries and Oceans Canada (Government of Canada).

Locations: Regional Headquarters in Dartmouth, NS, as well as Area Offices in Southwest Nova Scotia (Yarmouth) and Eastern Nova Scotia (Sydney). Telework arrangements and other locations in Nova Scotia may be considered, and can be discussed with successful candidates once screening has been completed.

<u>Work Terms</u>: Full-time (37.5 hours per week), for a period of <u>up to</u> 90 working days from May to August, or early September, 2023. Wages will be based on an annual salary of \$46,097.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Applicants must be a person who is a member of a Nova Scotia Mi'kmaw community and starting, or returning to, university/college in September 2023.
